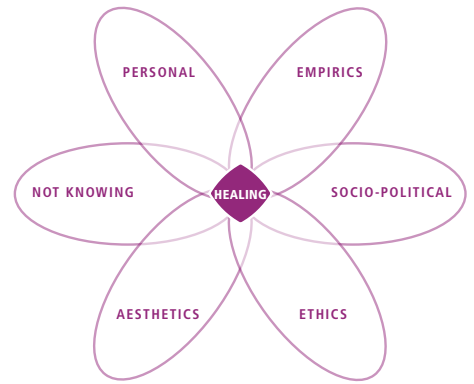


Figure 1.1c. Healing and Patterns of Knowing in Nursing (Personal, Aesthetics, Empirics, Ethics, Not Knowing, Socio-Political)

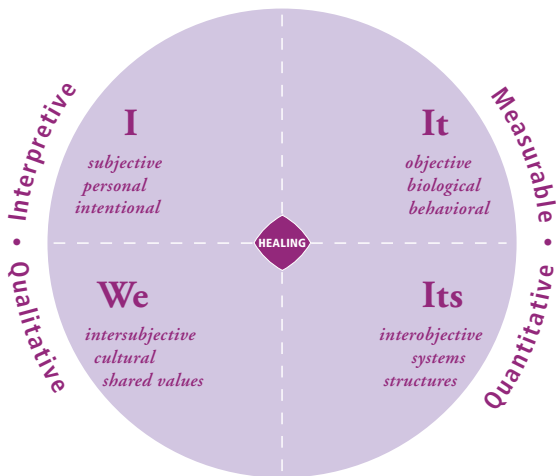


Figure 1.1d. Healing and Four Quadrants (I, We, It, Its)

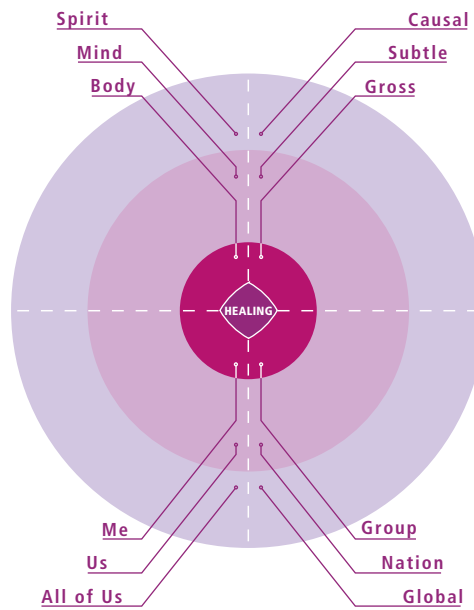


Figure 1.1e. Healing and AQAL (All Quadrants, All Levels)

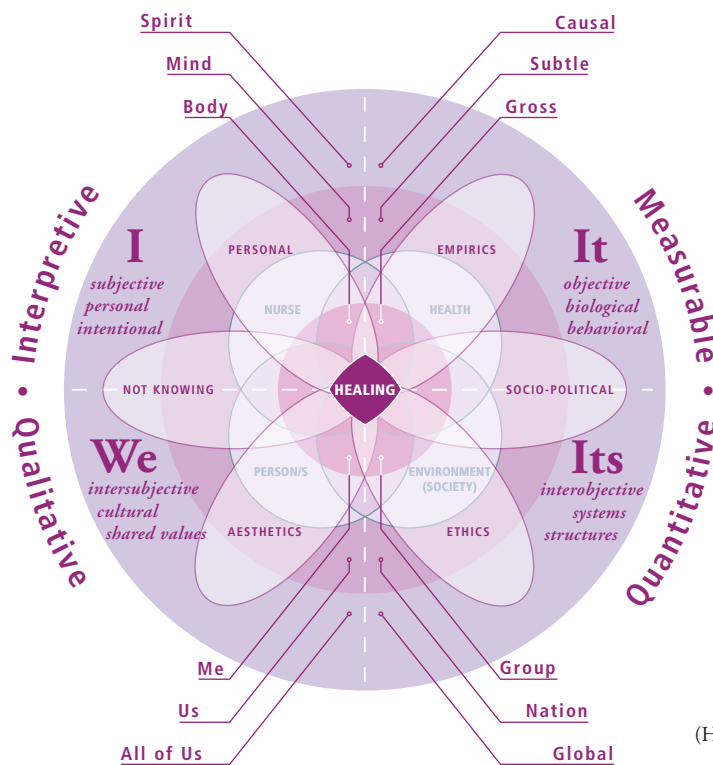


Figure 1.1f. Theory of Integral Nursing (Healing, Meta-Paradigm, Patterns of Knowing in Nursing, Four Quadrants and AQAL)
